The **Biosecurity Enhancement Initiative** supports the resiliency of the agriculture and food sector by addressing biosecurity risks and enhancing emergency preparedness. It provides funding opportunities to key agriculture industry businesses, including Primary Producers, Processors, and Service Providers. The Initiative has 7 Project Categories to support related activities across the full agri-food value chain (two for animal health and five for plant health).



#### **Plant Health Project Categories**

Schedule 3: assessment, planning, education and training

Schedule 4: sprayer upgrades for integrated pest management

Schedule 5: preventing introduction and spread of pests through isolation, sanitation and controlling of workflow

Schedule 6: innovative pest monitoring and management tools and equipment

Schedule 7: technologies and processes to reduce plant pest contamination and risk

Applications will be accepted as of September 19, 2023 on an ongoing basis until no later than January 6, 2025, subject to the availability of funding allocated to the Initiative.

Funding for the Initiative comes from the Sustainable Canadian Agricultural Partnership. Up to \$7,500,000 has been allocated for the Initiative.

#### **CSGA's Four Key Seed Regulatory Modernization Recommendations**

At CSGA, our vision for the future is based on trust—that Canadian producers have trust and confidence in the seed they're planting. We need a modern seed system that adapts quickly to change, creates a level playing field for all stakeholders, can deliver new technology, and is transparent and science-based.

CSGA's four key SRM policy recommendations are:

- **1. Main Administrator**: The future of our seed sector is a sector-led, government-enabled seed certification system with CSGA as the main administrator through a digital single window managing all seed certification functions on behalf of government.
- **2. Digital Single Window** access to seed certification services is the most efficient and effective tool to positively impact the seed value chain. It would eliminate duplicate and fragmented workflows, allowing users to access information in one place.
- **3. Variety Certification Eligibility Form 300**: We propose a new tier in Schedule III of the *Seeds Regulations*. We must eliminate redundancies in our parallel process to ensure the formal recognition of the identity of a variety by one authority.
- **4. Standards, Governance and Partnerships**: We have developed a plan to further expand stakeholder consultation and engagement by creating a Multi-Stakeholder Advisory Committee and increasing external representatives on CSGA committees.

Most of these recommendations have been supported in the recent CFIA Seed Regulatory Modernization (SRM) pre-consultation survey.
