out the pedigreed seed crop insurance program yet remember to ask Agricorp about it and manage your risk with programs that match the higher value of seed crops versus your commercial acreage.


Pedigreed Seed Crop Insurance

Crop Inspection Application Deadlines

Submit your application for seed crop certification and membership to the CSGA by the



following deadline dates:

- May 5 for winter canola/rapeseed
- May 25 for fall seeded cereals
- June 10 for fababeans, forages, flax, canola, mustard, corn and field peas
- June 20 for all other crops not listed here
- July 10 for field beans and buckwheat
- July 25 for soybeans
