Crop Inspection Application Deadlines

Spring will be here before you know it. Remember these important membership renewal and crop inspection application deadline dates:

- May 5 for winter canola/rapeseed
- May 25 for fall seeded cereals
- June 10 for fababeans, forages, flax, canola, mustard, corn and field peas
- June 20 for all other crops not listed here
- July 10 for field beans and buckwheat
- July 25 for soybeans
